Sowing Seeds of Faith

Today we hear the parable of the sower. In our presentation song today, we hear the words of the gospel reflected so beautifully. “A sower went out to sow the seed. Some of it fell upon the path, some fell on shallow rocky soil, and some among choking thorns.” How do we relate this to our everyday lives? As Christians, we are called to do good, to exemplify the love of Christ in our work, putting the ingredient of Christian principal into our thinking. In doing so, we are sowing seeds of good, allowing the love of Christ to radiate through us. At times, we encounter situations where no matter how hard we try we encounter barriers. Perhaps that could be equated to the seed falling on “rocky soil” For that seed to take we need to use persistence to make things work. It is the tantamount of, “Not giving up.”

If we look closer, we can safely say that our Gospel Reading today is all about having Faith. As we sing the hymn “Parable” we are reminded that if we keep the faith, we will yield a fruitful harvest.
